

1. This is an open show. Non-members are welcome to participate.
2. Registration fee will be \$1.00 per entry to a maximum of \$10.00. (10 entries)  
Additional entries are free of charge. Entry fees are non-refundable.
3. No entry may be entered in more than one class. It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that their fish are entered in the correct class. The Show Chairperson may assist if requested.
4. Power will be available at all show tables and if you want air for your entry please bring a vibrator pump. CAOAC will have a limited number of vibrator pumps available for use by exhibitors if required.
5. Entrants will supply their own tanks, airlines, airstone, valves and vibrator pumps.
6. Tanks must be covered with a rigid material (glass, plexi-glass, or egg crate) and it must be removable for judging.
7. While all possible provisions will be made to ensure the well being of the entries, CAOAC accepts no responsibility for loss or damage during the show.
8. Judging comes under the jurisdiction of the Canadian Association of Aquarium Clubs. Judging will be by certified CAOAC judges or other qualified persons as required, whose decisions are final and binding. Appeals will not be accepted the day of the show.
9. In cases of dispute, the Show Chairperson's decisions will be final and binding.
10. Junior classes are for entrants who are 16 years old or less on May 21st. Junior entries in adult classes are eligible for the Junior High Aggregate Award and the annual CAOAC Junior Champion of Champions Award, however it must note on their entry form that they are a junior.
11. If you intend to show an entry in a tank larger than 10 gallon, please advise Terry Little prior to the Convention.
12. Entries displaying any disease or deformity will be disqualified.
13. Except for the Novelty class and Aquarium & Bowl Beautiful class, no ornaments, or other items may be present in the tank, except for airline, air stones, filters, or heaters. Tank dividers may also be used but only in Family classes.
14. Novelty class and Aquarium & Bowl Beautiful class - No restrictions what so ever, except that the display must contain at least one live fish.

15. Family Classes - Entry will consist of one spawning pair and at least six (6) young from that pair not more than three (3) months of age, and bred by the entrant. Tank dividers may be used.

16. The show room will be open to allow entries between 4:00 – 7:00 pm on Friday May 21<sup>st</sup> and 8:00 am - 12:00 noon on Saturday May 22<sup>nd</sup> and all entries must remain on display until 2:00 pm on Sunday May 23<sup>rd</sup>. All entries must be removed by 6:00 pm on Sunday May 23<sup>rd</sup>. The show room will be closed on Saturday afternoon for judging.

17. Any Judge or their immediate families may not have an entry in the show. Any Apprentice Judge or their immediate families may not have an entry in any class judged by the Apprentice Judge.
