Dorothy Reimer explained the donation of two crests to the archivist files. One was the original crest from the Forest City Fish Breeders that was designed by her son Ray Reimer and the second was a crest from the Victoria Aquarium Society.

Budgets for committees: are due at the September meeting.

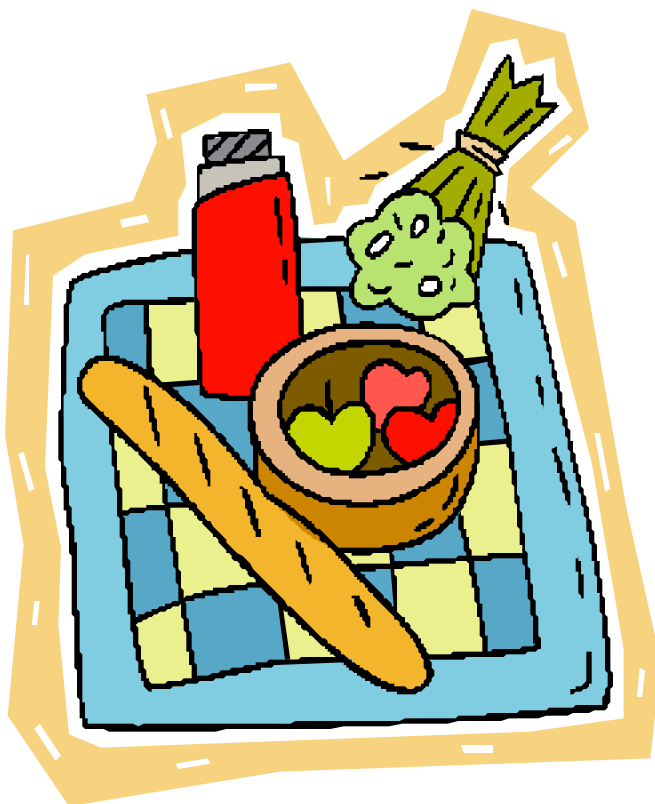
