Convention 2006: Dorothy Reimer (London Aq Soc) thanked all those who attended. Everyone seemed to have a great time – there were no complaints and much praise. Financially the club ended up with a small profit. 13 CAOAC clubs were represented and 29 other clubs were also represented (mostly by the speakers). That is probably a record for a CAOAC convention.

Convention 2007: Nothing so far. Any club wishing to host the 2007 convention should let CAOAC know by September at the latest. If no club is willing CAOAC will have to explore the possibility of hosting one themselves.

Voted on and carried. Still no apprentice judging reports received. There are six shows this fall - a great opportunity for the apprentices to meet the requirements for judging certificates.

Futures: Nothing to report. This is an ad hoc committee so we do not require a motion for the chairperson to continue.

Newsletter: Motion 0606-09 – that Micia Burden be accepted as editor and publisher for 2006 – 2007; Motioned by Terry Little (Open Show), seconded by Dorothy Reimer (London Aq Soc). Voted on and carried. Deadline for next issue is September 1st 2006. **Please check the calendar for show and auction dates – there are changes and additions.**

Open Show: Motion 0606-10 – that Terry Little be accepted as open show chair for 2006 – 2007; Motioned by Bill Irwin (Brant/Judges), seconded by Ken Boorman (Samia). Voted on and carried. Terry Little (Open Show) has compiled a list of the fall shows and it was distributed today. All are sanctioned to date except Brampton. Check web site and newsletter for current information on shows and auctions.

Voted on and carried. A suggestion was made that if possible the speaker programs that are on DVD be edited down to a more man-

ageably 60 minutes or less.

The Brant club is looking for a spring auction date and didn't want to take the CAOAC date. Brant was told to go ahead and if CAOAC decides to hold an auction we will work around them
