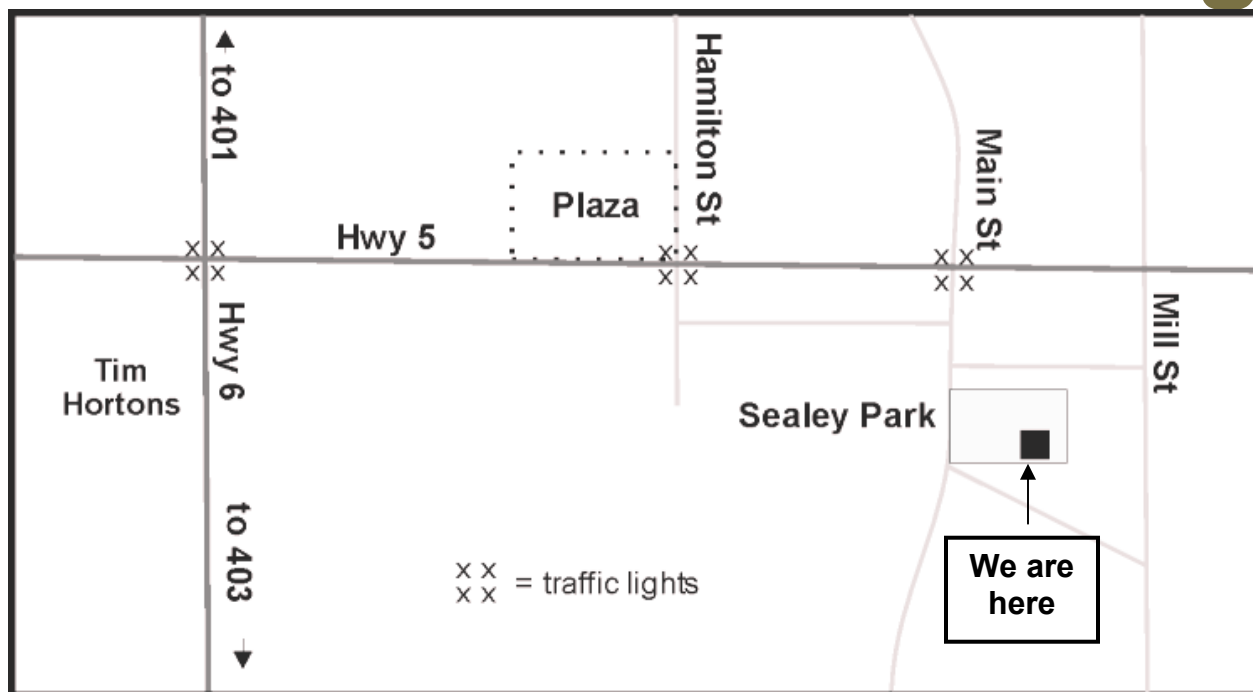

This award is for anybody affiliated with CAOAC.


The award will be part of the information binder of CAOAC under "Awards".

## CAOAC FUTURES COMMITTEE REPORT

CAOAC held a futures meeting at Carl McCleary's home October 10/2009. The meeting began at 1:30pm and went until 4:30pm. In attendance; Dave Boehm (KWAS, treasurer CAOAC), Phil Maznyk (KWAS, webmaster/newsletter/steering CAOAC), Tom Mason (DRAS), Carl McCleary (CDAS) Absent: Udo Rohmann (PRAS)

Listed below are the recommendations that came out of this first meeting.

### FUTURES COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

**1)** Object is to increase the amount of clubs in CAOAC.

- to do so, more has to be offered (ie to reptile clubs, marine societies, pond clubs)
- a CAOAC news bulletin should be sent to each club, either participating or non-participating. (quarterly?)
- news bulletin would be world tropical fish, marine, pond, reptile news, government changes in laws, new species found, info on C.A.R.E.S., invasive species, fish (reptile) rescue, hobby, industry, scientific.
- liaison to the Francophone clubs.
- teleconferencing calls to clubs out of regular meeting area (eastern, central, western) on a quarterly basis.
- show non CAOAC clubs the effective programs already in place (ie BAP, HAP, judges, Show, fish rescue)
- is it possible for U.S. clubs to get an insurance policy like ours, so they can join CAOAC.

**2)** To bring CAOAC business into each club.

- have a general meeting at a clubs auction/show.
- executive and club reps to visit different club meetings several times a year to bring in info, events calendar and question period.
- each club to have a small piece in newsletter (website) about CAOAC events, news (sent by CAOAC exec.)

**3)** PayPal will be setup on the CAOAC website.

- clubs can rejoin by submitting through PayPal for membership and insurance on CAOAC website.

**4)** Fish Rescue program works.

- need more documentation (ie who is it from, where did it go, date)
- need at least 1 person per club helping
- can be a potential funding project.
- promote to city, provincial and federal

**5)** CAOAC general meetings can be shortened in time. (Suggestions)

- all committees file reports 7 days beforehand to exec

to be reviewed

- executive agenda published to all executive and board of directors prior to meeting (maybe 4 days prior)
- these will be brought up at the general meeting if deemed necessary by the executive.
- some may be skimmed through, others may be discussed, voted upon or deleted.
- these reports can be submitted through the CAOAC website.
- having no committee report is common.

**6)** With shortened general meetings, more time can be spent having experts in to improve CAOAC reps in the hobby, (ie C.A.R.E.S., invasive species, conversation and scientific research).

**7)** Link CAOAC with University, colleges and school programs regarding the hobby.

**8)** Review judges standards and corporate By-laws.

- what needs trashing and what needs updating in by-laws.
- are all rules being followed by judges (ie IFGA, HADAS, etc.)
- voting for executive.
