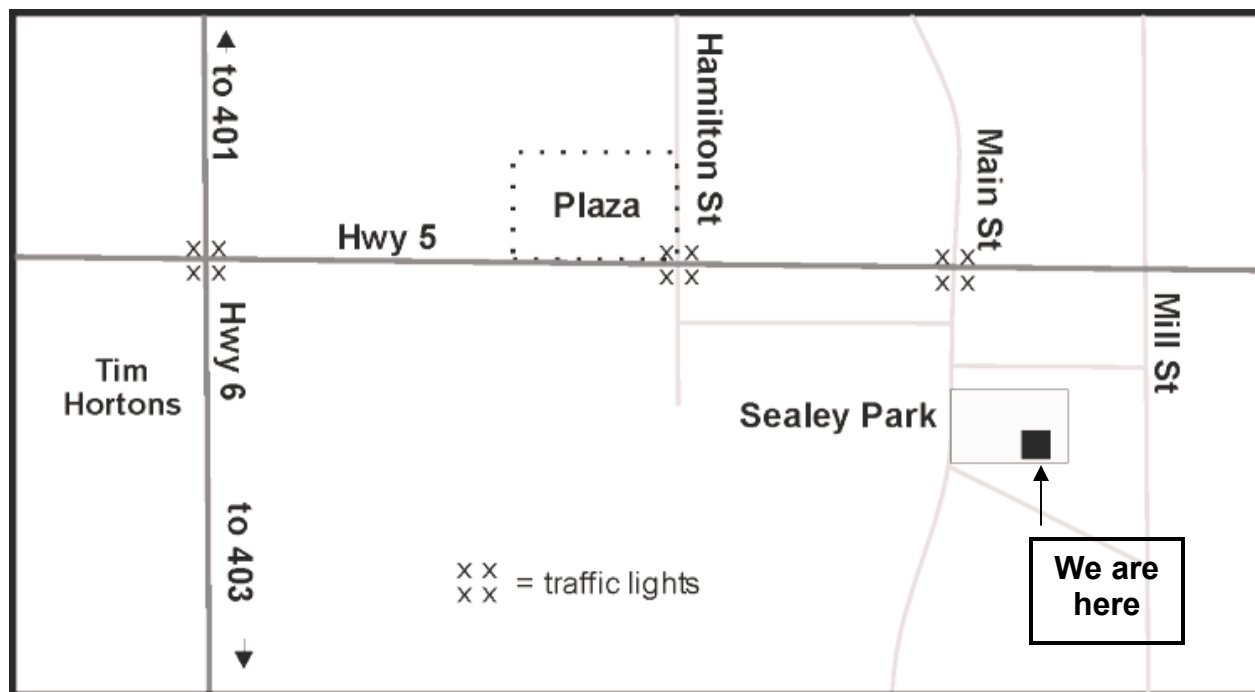

### **Matters arising from Previous Minutes:**

Audit – Was completed after last meeting. The time frame from when Dave Boehm took over was reviewed. Everything was in order and Neil was impressed with the condition of the books. Neil will give a written recommendation in regards to tracking assets and liabilities.

PIJAC membership still not completed, Dave has been very busy at work and will attend to it as soon as he can.

Ann Stevens attended the Reptile Expo in November and was surprised at the size and varieties on display. There were some cichlids there and a few others she didn't remember what they were. She also met with Grant and he was pleased to hear of the convention location next year and has suggested a meeting with him and the committee to discuss his further involvement.

Convention – Bob has received the finalized contract and will be contacting the caterer for the Hamilton speaker to inquire about her services to cater the convention banquet. Two days after the last CAOAC meeting, Fanshawe did send Bob a proposal, with the cost of the dinner increasing \$7.00 over last year. Ken still has not heard from David Boruchowitz whether he needs a kosher meal. Ken advised he has agreement from Ray Lucas to be the dinner speaker. The topic will be announced later.

Previously it had been decided that the awards meeting, traditionally held in March be held at a restaurant for a breakfast meeting at 9:00.

It was also decided that it may be better to hold it after the general meeting, since some people have so far to travel. The time will be firmed up as we get closer to the date. A motion was made that CAOAC will pay for the meals that day for those in attendance.
