



Dr. John Gratzek

Dr. Gratzek is a native of Minnesota. He is a graduate of the University of Minnesota College of Veterinary Medicine with a doctorate degree from the University of Wisconsin where he specialized in the study of infectious diseases. After a six year period of teaching and research at Iowa State University he was appointed Department Head of the Department of Medical Microbiology in the College of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Georgia — a position which he held for 27 years. In the past 18 years Dr. Gratzek has devoted his professional efforts towards questions of problems associated with the production and culture of fish. His publications include articles on water quality management, central systems, diseases of fish, fish immunology and virology. Dr. Gratzek is a past president of the American College of Veterinary Microbiologists and the International Association of Aquatic Animal Medicine. As of September 1, 1993, he retired from his administrative post and was appointed Emeritus Professor. He now teaches Fish Health Management in the College and will continue to offer the Annual Fish Health Management short course which is offered in August. Dr. Gratzek continues to consult on problems associated with tropical fish.

Ed Taylor

Ed Taylor is a lifelong aquarium hobbyist who has been keeping and breeding fish for over 28 years. He has a bachelor's degree in Chemistry from Duke University and a master's degree in biological sciences from Old Dominion University. His graduate work was concentrated in the fields of fish systematics and animal behavior. Ed owned and operated his own fish hatchery in Virginia for over 15 years before moving to Florida. In Florida, he worked for two of the largest fish farms as a hatchery manager and livestock salesman. As a hobbyist and professional breeder, Ed has spawned and raised over 450 species of tropical fish. For a period of almost 3 years, Ed worked for TFH Publications as the editor or assistant editor of Tropical Fish Hobbyist magazine. He also has experience as a petshop retailer, fish importer, and industry journalist and photographer. Over 100 articles have appeared in aquarium hobby and industry trade magazines written by Ed. At present, he is a participating member of an aquarium service company in Orlando, Florida. Ed has been a member of numerous hobby organizations. He was first elected chairman of the American Cichlid Association in 1969, and served as the Federation of American Aquarium Society's first president in 1971. He is well-known as a workshop speaker and fish show judge. In June of 1993, Ed was selected by Thomas's Europe (the manufacturer of AQUARIAN fish foods) to be the head of the US AQUARIAN Advisory Service (USAAS). This entity has been established by Thomas's to aid the aquarist in their fishkeeping. Recently, Ed has completed a book which will be published by TFH Publications. Its title is yet to be selected but the subject matter is well-known to most hobbyists livebearers. The tentative title of the work is Florida Ornamental Livebearers. It illustrates and discusses in detail virtually every variety of swordtail, platy, variatus, and molly raised on Florida fish farms. The book also contains chapters on the fish farming industry in general, and livebearer farming in particular. This is the first treatment of this subject in hobby literature and it will be of great interest both to the hobby and the trade. Ed's talk will cover selected points of interest from the book.


