C. A. O. A. C.

The Canadian Association of Aquarium Clubs is a group of people representing aquarium clubs from Canada and northern U.S.A. We were formed twenty years ago with the aim of promoting, helping, and encouraging anyone with an interest in things aquatic. Our activities are directed and controlled by a body of representatives from more than thirty clubs and societies located in Canada, and including active member clubs in the northern U.S.A.

Our purpose is to assist member clubs with their activities in the aquarium hobby in any possible way, with emphasis on program material and communications. C.A.O.A.C. is not a club, nor is it a separate body having a purpose unto itself. It is, in fact, a centralized forum for member clubs to use to meet, work, play, and discuss anything and everything of interest to them.

Show Rules



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

The show is open for participation by all tropical fish hobbyists whether a member of a tropical fish club or not.

LIMIT OF ENTRIES

There will be no limit to the number of entries submitted.

JUDGING

Judging will be done by C.A.O.A.C. certified judges where possible and the decision of all judges is final and binding.

DISEASED FISH

Fish displaying any form of disease or deformity may not be entered and if entered will be disqualified.

SHOW CONTAINERS

Guppies and Bettas must be shown in drum bowls. All other fish entries must be shown in square gallon jars or aquariums but must be no larger than required to accommodate the fish. All containers must be supplied by the exhibitors.

CONTENTS OF SHOW CONTAINERS

The bowls in classes 4-8 and 17-21 shall contain only water and fish (no air stones allowed). The tanks and jars in all other classes except 39, 40, 41 & 42 shall contain fish, water and air stones only. The only exception to this rule will be that small box filters will be allowed in tanks where the exhibitor feels an airstone is not sufficient to keep the fish healthy or the water clean for the duration of the show. Any difficulty in judging the fish due to the inclusion of the box filters will be strictly the exhibitors responsibility.

AIR SUPPLY

Air will be supplied to all display shelves except Guppies and Bettas. Exhibitors must supply their own three-way valves, air stones, air lines and box filters. No open air lines will be allowed.

ENTRIES IN THE WRONG CLASS

It is the exhibitors responsibility to enter the fish in the correct class but the judges have the right to re-classify any entries they feel are in the wrong class.

ENTRIES IN MORE THAN ONE CLASS

No entry will be allowed in more than one class.

ENTRY TIMES

Entries will be accepted from 5.00 P.M. to 11.00 P.M. on Friday May 18, 1979, 9.00 A.M. to 5.00 P.M. on Saturday May 19/79, and 7.00 A.M. to 9.30 A.M. on Sunday May 20/79.

REMOVAL OF ENTRIES

Entries may not be removed from the Show until completion of the Awards Banquet on Sunday May 20/79. Anyone wishing to leave their fish in the Show Room until Monday May 21/79 may do so, but all entries must be removed by 12.00 Noon.

TIME OF JUDGING

Judging will commence at 10.00 A.M. on Sunday May 20, 1979.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee will be \$1.00 for each entry registered on or before Thursday May 17/79. Any late entries will be subject to an entry fee of \$1.25 each. Make cheques payable to Brant Aquarium Society.

AUCTION

An auction of fish and supplies will be held at times listed elsewhere in this publication. Anyone wishing their show entries put into the auction are asked to contact the show committee. Fish and decorative materials in tank classes will not be accepted for auction because the tanks must remain complete until teardown due to public viewing.

The Brant Aquarium Society will retain one half of the proceeds. The doners portion of the proceeds will be sent by mail to these people within one week of the auction. No money will be paid to doners on the day of the auction.

HOURS OF FISH DISPLAY

The show will be open to exhibitors at the conclusion of the judging. We anticipate this will be 2.00 P.M.

ENTRY DEADLINE

Entries should be submitted no later than May 17, 1979. Late entries will be accepted as space permits at an additional charge as outlined under Entry Fees.

LOSSES

The Brant Aquarium Society, The Holiday Inn, C.A.O.A.C. or any of their representatives will not be responsible for any loss or damage to fish or equipment of any exhibitor. Exhibitors should take extra care when supplying tops on tanks holding fish that are jumpers. They should be covered with glass or other strong lids to avoid them from leaving the tanks. The representatives of the Brant Aquarium Society will take every precaution to avoid damage or loss of any exhibit but the exhibitors must take extra care with the large or overactive fish to avoid any problems.

WATER

Water will be available but will not be aged. The water in Brantford has a P.H. of 7.5, a D.H. of 100 P.P.M., and contains flouride.

TROPHIES

We have decided this year to award special plaques instead of trophies for the first prize in each class. We hope this will not deter any entries from coming to our show. The plaques will be designed around our club emblem as shown on the front cover of this publication. It is very unique and if you are one of the fortunate people to win one of these plaques, we feel sure you will be proud to have it hang in a very prominent place in your fish room. The second and third in each class will be a very colourful 7 ribbon rosette complete with a centre button showing the emblem of the Brant Aquarium Society in full colour as is shown on the front cover of this bulletin. Everyone that won last year will no doubt remember them as the best looking rosette awarded at any show in recent years and we hope these little frills will promote our show as one of the largest and best in the C.A.O.A.C. show circuit.

TANK AND BOWL BEAUTIFUL

Tank and Bowl Beautiful must be all natural and contain at least one fish.

BACKGROUNDS

One colour plain backgrounds are allowed and must be supplied by the exhibitor.

SEXING FISH

Unless otherwise specified, all fish are to be shown in pairs. A pair is considered to be a male and female of the same species and only where sex cannot be distinguished will two fish be considered a pair.

ADMISSION TO SHOW

Admission to the show will be \$1.00 per person. Exhibitors, children under 14 years old, and old age pensioners will be admitted free.

GUPPY ENTRIES

Female guppies will be allowed in the jars with male guppies but will not be judged as part of the entry.

Prints can be any size. Prints must never have been sold for publication. Entrants name and address must be printed on the back of each entry.
