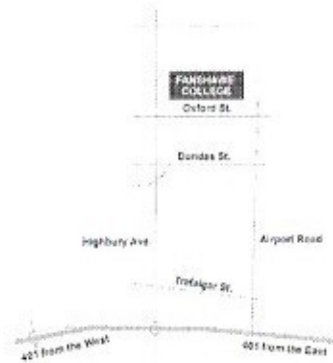

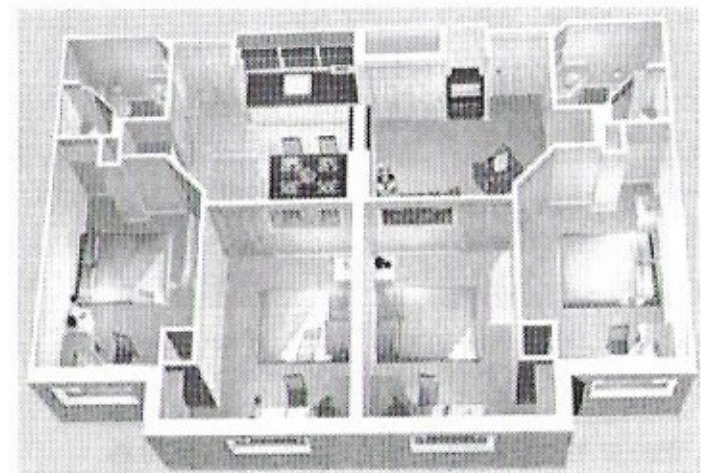
## ACCOMMODATIONS
